07.ADMISSION PROCEDURES FOR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS



In accordance with G.O Ms. No. 34 Higher Education dated 15-10-2020, an Online Admission Process has been implemented for undergraduate programs in degree colleges across Andhra Pradesh. This initiative aims to promote merit, ensure excellence, curb malpractices, and conduct fair, non-discriminatory admissions in a transparent manner for the benefit of the student community. As per G.O Ms. No. 46 HE(CE) dated 22-12-2020, non-professional degree programs will now be structured as 4-year Honours Programs starting from the academic year 2020-21, with an exit option available after 3 years.

Eligible candidates who have completed their education from the Board of Intermediate, AP, or other recognized boards can participate in web counselling for available seats in various undergraduate programs, including B.A., B.Sc., B.Com., BBA, and B.Voc, among others. This applies to Government Degree Colleges, Government Autonomous Degree Colleges, Private Aided and Unaided Degree Colleges, and Private Autonomous Degree Colleges in the state. The online admission process includes registration, payment of the processing fee, certificate verification, and selection of web options.

Verification of Certificates

Upon successful payment of the processing fee, candidates will receive an Application Number and Password via SMS to the mobile number provided during pre-registration. Candidates must complete the online application by uploading their photograph and signature. Those whose certificate data is verified can proceed to exercise web options. If data is incomplete, candidates will receive an SMS instructing them to attend certificate verification at a Help Line Centre (HLC).

Helpline Centers: There are at least four HLCs in each district for assistance. Candidates whose data is verified can directly proceed to option entry without visiting HLCs.

- Candidates can exercise web options using their Application Number, date of birth, and password from home, an internet café, or an HLC.
- Candidates with unverified data will receive a message to visit the nearest HLC for verification.

Payment of Processing Fee

Eligible candidates can pay the processing fee for admission online through the website oamdc.ap.gov.in. The approximate fee structure is as follows:

- Rs. 400 for OC candidates
- Rs. 300 for BC candidates
- Rs. 200 for SC & ST candidates

Payment Methods: Candidates can pay using credit card, debit card, or net banking. To make a payment, follow these steps:

1. Visit oamdc.ap.gov.in and fill in the required details on the Pre-Registration Page.
2. Click on "Proceed to Payment" to be directed to the payment gateway.
3. Select your preferred payment method and enter the necessary credentials.

Transaction Charges:

- Credit Card (Visa/Master/Rupay): 1% of the transaction
- Debit Card (Rupay): No charges
- Debit Card (Visa/Master): 0.90%
- UPI: No charges
- Internet Banking: Rs. 10 per transaction

Ensure to complete the payment process to proceed with your admission application.

- Residence Certificate (if no institutional education)
- Andhra Pradesh Residence Certificate of parents (for non-local candidates)
- Integrated Community Certificate (for BC/ST/SC)
- Income Certificate or White Ration Card (for fee reimbursement)
- Local Status Certificate (if applicable)
- Certificates for special categories (NCC, Sports, PH, CAP).

Special Category Admissions :

Candidates belonging to special categories such as CAP, NCC, Sports, and Physically Challenged must report to specified Help Line Centres for verification on designated dates.

Spot Admissions :

Leftover seats after the final phase can be filled through Spot Admissions in accordance with APSCE guidelines. Processing Fee for Spot Admission is Rs. 400 for all categories with a late fee fine of Rs. 100.

Management Quota Admissions

Management quota seats (30% Category-B) can be filled by private unaided colleges. Processing Fee for Management Quota Admission is Rs. 500 for all categories, with a late fee fine of Rs. 100. Candidates admitted under this quota are not eligible for fee reimbursement.

Important Notes :

- Candidates must complete the online application and exercise web options to be considered for seat allotment.
- Detailed instructions for option entry will be available on the homepage of oamdc.ap.gov.in.

09.PG PROFESSIONAL COURSES: MCA & MBA PROGRAMS ADMISSION PROCEDURES

Qualified candidates of the AP ICET seeking admission into MBA and MCA programs in Andhra Pradesh are invited to participate in the web counselling process. The counselling will occur in three phases: First, Second, and Final. Candidates are encouraged to follow the guidelines provided for a smooth admission experience.

Key Steps in the Web Counselling Process

1. **Registration for Web Counselling:** Candidates must register online to initiate the counselling process.
2. **Verification of Certificates:** All required documents will be verified to ensure eligibility.
3. **Exercising Web Options:** Candidates can select their preferred colleges and courses during this phase.
4. **Change of Web Options:** Candidates have the opportunity to modify their selections within the specified timeframe.
5. **Seat Allotment:** Seats will be allocated in three phases: first, second, and final.
6. **Self-Reporting to College:** Candidates must report to the allotted college to confirm their admission.

Participation Requirements :

Eligible candidates are required to pay a processing fee to participate in the web counselling for available seats in universities and colleges offering MBA and MCA programs. For more detailed information regarding the admission process, including the schedule and specific requirements, candidates should refer to the official website of the Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education (APSCHE).

Payment of Processing Fee

Before proceeding with online certificate verification, candidates must pay a processing fee to participate in the AP ICET web counselling for MBA and MCA programs. The details are as follows:

• Processing Fee:

- Rs. 1200 for OC/BC candidates | -Rs. 600 for SC/ST/PH candidates

Payment Instructions

1. Candidates can make the payment online using a credit card, debit card, or net banking through the "Pay Processing Fee" link on the official website: APSCHE.
2. All candidates, from the first to the last rank, can pay the processing fee starting from the specified date.
3. To pay the processing fee:
 - o Visit APSCHE and click on "Pay Processing Fee." | o Enter your AP ICET Hall Ticket number and rank, then click on "Pay Fee Online."
 - o You will be directed to the payment gateway.
 - o Choose your preferred payment method (credit card, debit card, or net banking) and enter the required credentials.
 - o After successful payment, click on the print button to obtain a receipt.

Important Note: Candidates must ensure that the processing fee is paid before uploading the scanned copies of their certificates.

Eligibility Criteria for MBA and MCA Programs

Candidates must meet the following eligibility requirements to apply for the MBA and MCA programs:

MBA : Candidates must have a minimum of 50% aggregate marks (45% for SC/ST/BC) in any degree of at least three years duration, with Mathematics as one of the subjects in SSC.

MCA : Candidates must have :

- o Passed BCA or a Bachelor's degree in Computer Science Engineering or an equivalent degree with at least 50% marks (45% for reserved categories), or
- o Passed B.Sc./B.Com./B.A. with Mathematics at the 10+2 level or at graduation level (with additional bridge courses as per university norms) with at least 50% marks (45% for reserved categories).

Important Notes for AP ICET 2025 Candidates

- **Option Exercising :** All qualified candidates of AP ICET 2025 can exercise their options from any internet café, help line center, or from their residence after certificate verification on the specified dates. Detailed procedures for exercising options will be available on the official website: APSCHE.
- **Freezing of Options:** Once options are exercised, they will be frozen, and candidates will not be able to make further changes.
- **Seat Allotment:** The results of seat allotment will be published on the official website.
- **Additional Information:** For further details regarding the admission process, candidates should refer to the official website.
- **Fee and Seat Availability:** Information regarding fee particulars and available seats under the Convener Quota, organized by college, will be accessible on the website well before the commencement of option entry.
- **Scholarship Eligibility:** According to Government Orders (G.O.Ms.No.77 and G.O.Ms.No.4), the "Post Matric Scholarships (RTF)" and "Post Matric Scholarships (MTF)" schemes are applicable only to students admitted under the Convener Quota in state-funded universities and government colleges for postgraduate programs from the academic year 2020-21. These scholarships do not apply to students admitted under the Convener Quota in private aided and unaided colleges.

AP ICET Category-B Admissions

The institution will facilitate a web portal for filling up Category-B (Non-NRI) and 15% NRI quota seats for the MBA and MCA programs. Below are the key details regarding the admission process:

Key Admission Steps :

- **Commencement of Category-B Admissions:** Registration for Category-B admissions will begin on the specified date.
- **Uploading of Category-B Admissions:** Candidates can upload their admissions on the web portal without incurring a late fee.
- **Payment of Processing Fee:** Candidates can pay the processing fee through the payment gateway without a late fee during the designated period.
- **Late Fee for Processing Fee:** If the processing fee is paid after the deadline, a late fee of Rs. 2000 per day will be applicable.

Registration Fees

The registration fee for candidates is as follows:

- Qualified in AP ICET 2024: **Rs. 1200**
- Not Qualified/Not Appeared in AP ICET 2024: **Rs. 1600**
- Supernumerary Quota (PIO/FN/CWG): **Rs. 5000**

11.CODE OF CONDUCT

At St. Ann's College for Women, we uphold a strong commitment to fostering a respectful and disciplined academic environment. All admitted students are required to adhere strictly to the rules and regulations established by the college. Any violation of these rules will be documented in the College Record as a warning. After three recorded violations, the college reserves the right to terminate or expel the student at any stage. The following guidelines must be observed:

1. College Timings:

Classes are held from Monday to Friday, 8:55 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and on Saturday, 8:55 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Attendance at the morning assembly is compulsory, and students are expected to participate with respect and attention.

2. Dress Code:

Students must wear the designated college uniform at all times. Modesty in attire is mandatory to maintain the college's standards.

3. Jewelry Policy:

To promote a conducive physical and psychological environment, students should wear minimal jewelry and dress modestly.

4. Identity Card:

Upon admission, each student will receive an identity card signed by the principal, serving as proof of their status. Students must carry their identity cards at all times and present them when required. Loss of the identity card must be reported immediately, and a replacement will incur a fee. In case of transfer or withdrawal, the card must be surrendered for clearance.

5. Mobile Phone Policy:

Cell phones are permitted on campus solely for internships and online training classes. Unnecessary use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited. Any student found using a mobile phone in classrooms, corridors, or offices will face disciplinary action, which may include confiscation of the device. Personal photography and video recording during college programs are not allowed.

6. Two-Wheeler Regulations:

Students arriving on two-wheelers must submit a copy of their date of birth, driving license, and an undertaking to always wear a helmet and not ride with more than one passenger.

7. Notice Board:

Students are encouraged to regularly check the college notice board for important announcements and updates.

8. Loitering Policy:

Students should refrain from loitering around the Principal's chamber, corridors, or in front of classrooms without a valid reason. The waiting hall is designated for free time.

9. Vehicle Etiquette:

Students are not permitted to sit on parked vehicles or use them as surfaces for writing. Violators may incur a fine of Rs. 50/-.

10. Communication with Parents:

Students should share important messages sent via WhatsApp groups with their parents and respond to notices regarding APSCE and ANU notifications, fee payments, examination schedules, and results.

11. Anti-Ragging Policy:

Ragging is strictly prohibited and punishable under the Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1996.

Word to Parents : We kindly request parents to support their wards in maintaining regularity and punctuality in attendance, academic progress, and overall behavior.

- Parents are expected to respond promptly to communications from college authorities and are encouraged to attend Parent-Teacher Meetings when scheduled.

Attendance Policy Overview:

To be eligible for semester-end examinations conducted by the university, students must maintain a minimum attendance of 75% for each semester. This requirement is crucial for ensuring that students are adequately engaged in their studies.

Consequences of Low Attendance:

If a student's attendance falls below the 75% threshold, it is considered a shortfall. In such cases, the student will be required to pay a condonation fee to the university. Additionally, they will also need to pay the examination fee to be allowed to sit for the semester-end exams. This policy emphasizes the importance of regular attendance in maintaining academic standards and eligibility for assessments.

Leave in emergency & Leave Application Guidelines:

If a student is unable to attend college for one day, two days, or more due to illness, family weddings, functions, personal issues or other commitments, such as participation in sports, NCC camps, or other external activities, they are required to submit a leave application to the class in-charge. The application must include the following:

- Signature of the Parent: This indicates that the parent is aware of the student's absence.
- Principal's Signature: The application must also be signed by the principal to ensure it is officially recognized.

Scholarships Eligibility :

Maintaining 75% attendance is also mandatory for students to be eligible for scholarships provided by the state and central government. This reinforces the significance of consistent attendance not only for academic success but also for financial support opportunities.

Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA):

Attendance is compulsory for all Continuous Internal Assessments and practical sessions throughout each semester. Participation in these assessments is critical for evaluating student progress and comprehension of course material.

Practical and Lab Attendance:

Attendance in practical and laboratory sessions is also mandatory, as these components are integral to the academic curriculum.

Payment of College Fee :

Once a student is enrolled in a program, they are expected to complete it. If a student wishes to leave the college at any time before the completion of the academic year, they will be required to pay the entire fee for that particular academic year.

- o Fees should be paid every semester, either in cash or through a scanner at the college.
- o Please note that once the fee is paid, it is neither refundable nor transferable.

Issuance of Transfer Certificate (T.C.):

- The Transfer Certificate (T.C.) will be issued three days after the receipt of the application for the T.C.
- It is the responsibility of the applicant to promptly inform the principal of any clerical errors in the issued certificate and request corrections. The college will not be held responsible for any mistakes identified after the issuance of the certificate.

Issuance of Study Certificate

The Study Certificate will be issued **one day after the receipt of the application** for the certificate.
