ADMISSION PROCEDURE

UG COURSES:

The admissions of the college shall be based on merit at the qualifying exam.

Admission procedure takes place in the following sequence:

- Notification calling for application and admissions schedule will be issued in daily Newspaper of wide circulation and displayed on the noticeboard.
- Application forms for admission and copies of prospectus are to be obtained by the candidate at the admission desk.
- As per the university rules, seats are reserved for outstanding sports persons, N.C.C candidates, Children of Armed Forces and physically challenged etc;
- **4.** The candidates should submit the duly filled in application within the prescribed time, enclosing the authentic copies of the following:

a) Two attested copies of Marks statement of Intermediate examination.

b) Migration or Transfer certificate from the Head of the Institution last studied.

c) Three Passport size photographs.

- 5. Incomplete and incorrect applications will be rejected.
- 6. Students provisionally selected for admission should appear before the Principal on the date fixed and the time specified with necessary fees and documents:

 - d) Marks list of Intermediate
 - e) Original S.S.C Certificate
 - f) Two Passport size photos
 - g) Three sets of Photostat copies of above certificates.
- 7. The details of the fees can be obtained from the college office.
- No refund of fees will be entertained if the parent decides to withdraw the student from college.

P.G COURSES:

Admissions for PG Courses (MCA & MBA) is done by merit in the common entrance test i.e., I-CET through ICET Counseling subject to the eligibility criteria as specified by the Nagarjuna University. The seats are allotted category-wise as per the Government rules and regulations.

ATTENDANCE:

The college lays absolute stress on attendance. It is compulsory for the students to have a minimum of 75% in each subject and general attendance to be eligible to appear for the final examinations.

The hall is for the use of both UG & PG sections.

6. SICK-ROOM: Restoration place:

A sound and healthy mind is better than treasures of the world. Therefore instead of creating disturbing, gloomy feeling among the students in class room, a sick student is sent to the sickroom for recuperation and restoration in between the hours. Sick room is provided with all requirements and amenities.

7. WASH-ROOMS: Health and Hygiene:

Cleanliness is next to godliness. The cleaning work of the college especially of the wash rooms by Ayahs are regularly monitored by the authorities. Toilets are built in every floor to meet the needs of students and staff.

8. GYMNASIUM: Fitness for health: To keep the mind alert and active,

physical activity is also needed to the students. The controlled exercise makes a person fit as fiddle. Gymnasium has the Exercise cycle and aerobice quipment to warmup the sport persons and other interested people and buildup their fitness.

9. WATER SUMP AND COOLERS: Thirst quencher :

A huge water sump is built at the north eastern portion of the campus. It has the capacity to store water of two tankers.Corporation work is pumped in to it.The water is then pumped in to overhead tanks for the use in the hostel and college.The Authorities monitor the cleaning of the sump from time to time.Aqua guard water filters and coolers are fixed on every floor to ensure drinking of pure, safe and clean water. Prevention is better than cure.

10. CANTEEN: Place of Yummy Delicacies :

Hygiene and reasonably priced eatables are sold in canteen. The staff and students relax quenching the thirst and hunger. Stationary is also sold in the canteen to meet the emergency needs of students.

11. HOSTEL: Cocoon of Safety and Rest:

The college provides hostel facility within the campus under the supervision of sisters in secure environment. Well furnished rooms and hygienic food and medical assistance are provided. Study hours are conducted in a spacious hall.
