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



1. Effects to effectively cover prescribed Syllabus.




Majority of the students i.e.; 77% were responded excellent about the learning values like concept development, knowledge, understanding, attitudes and skills etc

4. Rate the depth of syllabus of the course in relation to the competencies expected by industry/current global scenario.




75% of the students were rated excellent that the depth of the syllabus of the course in relation to the competencies expected by industry current global scenario.

5. Opportunity to participate in seminar/workshop/conferences/research projects.




77% positively responded excellent that Teachers encourage them to participate and involve in seminars/workshops/conferences and research projects.

6. Library ambience is good for informal and Self-learning.




An excellent percentage of students i.e:73% responded that the library ambience is good for informal and self learning

7. Sports and Games Facilities




77% of students strongly agreed that the sports and games facilities are excellent.

8. Internal Examination Evaluation and Assessment Process




76% of the Students rated excellent that evaluation process is fair and unbiased they expressed support for the continuous internal assessment (CIA) being followed by the University.

9. Training and Placement Cell




77% were satisfied with the training and placement cell support in pursuing jobs while they are studying is excellent.




10. How is the standard of education and general ambience in the College?


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


1. How do you feel about the structure and relevance of the curriculum.



46% of teachers agreed that the structure and relevance of curriculum is verygood. 2. Are the electives offered in the curriculum related to technological advancements?




39% of Faculty expressed that the electives offered in the curriculum are related to technological advancements is very good.




academic flexibility in the curriculum is very good.

4. How well the curriculum caters to the industry requirements?




It has been noticed that the curriculum has framed to caters the industry requirements (about 46%). Is very good.




46% of Faculty has expressed that the curriculum is very good in improving the innovative thinking

7. Do you think the prescribed curriculum leads to practical exposure regarding modern tools?




It was found that 42% of teachers agreed that the curriculum leads to practical exposure with the usage of modern tools is very good.

8. How much is the curriculum able to improve teamwork abilities?




46% of Faculty has rated good that the curriculum has framed to improve team work abilities.

50% of Faculty has expressed satisfaction that the syllabus is effectively very good in developing entrepreneurship skills



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
