Description:

The most well-known and effective mass movement in the series of agitations organized by Gandhi during the war for freedom was the movement to leave India, also known as the Revolt of 1942 or the "August Revolution" of 1942. The Second World War had already begun when this massive migration was organized, and the sky was already dark and overcast due to the Japanese invasion of India.

The Cripps Mission's efforts were in vain, and prices for necessities were skyrocketing. However, the day of liberation from British imperialism does not seem far off. Gandhi frequently encouraged the British to "Leave India to God or to anarchy" and said, "This orderly disciplined anarchy should go, and if as a result there is complete lawlessness, I would risk it." According to Sumit Sarkar, "The summer of 1942 found Gandhi in a strange and uniquely militant mood. "The man who 'promised' Swaraj within a year is restless and keen to see that his aim of securing freedom for India is quickly realized, as seen by his words made in May 1942. Though the need for non-violence was constantly emphasized, Gandhi's motto of "Do or Die" best captures his combative demeanor, as Sumit Sarkar notes.
