Mr. Ch. Srinivas Rao Program Officer, STEP arranged this program.

Principal & Correspondent of the College Dr. Sr. Fatima Rani. P as the Chairperson of the program, Smt. K. Supraja, Addl SP, Urban Guntur as the Chief Guest and Smt. S. Pallavi Chief Executive Officer, STEP, Swasakti, Guntur as the Guest of Honour were invited. The program was conducted systematically starting with the Bible reading by Mrs. R. Sharon Rose, Vice- Principal, followed by Prayer song by Student Sisters and welcoming the Guests. The program was inaugurated by the lighting of lamp by the Guests and the Principal.

Many Day to day events happening on the Women atrocities were illustratively explained with examples to bring awareness to the young Women Students. Proper utilization of Media such as Instagram, Facebook, What's app and posting and sharing of personal data & photographs in Media was elaborately brought to understanding to the Students to avoid the Cyber crimes.

Smt. S. Pallavi, Chief Executive Officer, STEP, Swasakti, Guntur had explained to the students about Domestic Violence Cases, sexual harassments in family, work places, peer groups and many gender differences in the society in large. Installation and mode of work in Women Help Line Centers, Sakthi Centers, Vanitha Sahayavani,

Free tele-counselling and police assistance, Tara Women Centre (NGO Ashraya) etc for the safety and security of Women is highlighted.

The other Resource persons **Kumari D. Kiranmai, District Youth Officer, Nehru Yuvakendram**, encouraged the young women Students of College to focus on Character building and avoid over exposure of themselves to the modifications, trends and Fancies of Society to prevent themselves to fall as prey into the Hands of some Directors and Managers of Fashion designing and **K. Vijaya Kumari, Legal Adviser of Child and Women Welfare Committee (CWC Department)** were also participated in this programme and advised the Students to become the Strong

Women Citizens and Leaders of India. She drew the attention of students by portraying many Women leaders of the Universe in all walks of life.
