OBJECTIVES:

- > To indicate principles and procedures for combating sexual harassment.
- > To design a detailed plan of action, both short and long term.

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITY OF ANTI-SEXUAL HARASSMENT COMMITTEE:

- > To provide educational environment free from sexual harassment.
- > To extend information to all students about Anti sexual harassment and about their responsibility not to be sexually harassed.
- > To take active measures to prevent the harassment occurring. To redress any oral/written complaint about unwelcomed sexual advances and unwelcomed requests for sexual favors.
- > To handle the matter of sexual harassment very sensitively for the students under the Sexual Harassment Complaints Resolution Procedures.
- > To conduct awareness programmes on sexual harassment issues and also to display anti sexual harassment posters in prominent areas in the campus.
